Nederland waterland - Coastline			
Design in OASIS® BIO Floral Foam			
Almost a third of the Netherlands is below sea level. Without dikes, more than half of the country could even be flooded come to be. Fortunately, the Netherlands have a long tradition of dealing with water. Consider the Zuiderzee Works, the Delta Works and the beach pole system used by Rijkswaterstaat to measure the height and width of the beach and dune area and to keep the ebb and flow current away from the coast.			
To bring the feeling of the water and beach to the World Forum in The Hague the Organizers will provide a pre constructed prop see Annex #07_Technical details task 3 will be published on the official website (www.worldcupfloralart.com/competitors) at Oktober 1, 2024. Competitors may bring their own materials for a framework, base or support which are allowed in PL-1, and PL-2, added to this provided construction.			
The pre-construction may not be taken apart or cut and must stay dominantly visible. Alteration for example gluing, screwing, drilling, painting are acceptable. Take safety into account!			
Minimum 50% of used live materials must be placed in OASIS® BIO Floral Foam.			
Minimum 50% of ordered products from OASIS® must be used in the design.			
The design and materials are expected to last 4 days.			
The total arrangement must not exceed a ground space of 120 cm x 120 cm and a height (from the floor) of 190 cm.

Requirements	On the preparation day (Wednesday) you will all receive the same surprise package of botanical materials from our main sponsors Marginpar and Decorum. At least 50% of this package has a stem length of min. 70 cm. The competitor must transport the bouquet by hand. The judges will need to handle/remove the design for judging purposes. The design must be			
	detachable from the container it is displayed in. The container will be judged as a part of the workpiece. At least 80% of all alive materials must reach the water in the used container from Jodeco Glass.
