











## ANNEX #02 VENUE OF THE COMPETITION (B1) AND DELIVERY OF MATERIALES (B3)

## Venue of the competition (B1)

- There is currently no additional information to report on this section compared to the current regulations. More related information will follow at Annex #04\_Work space / facilities (B5) and displaying of the work (B9) and/or as soon as the final number of candidates is finalized at the end of March.

## **Delivery of materials (B3)**

- Candidate and assistant arrive on Tuesday 26.08.2025 for the preliminary meeting.
  World Forum The Hague is easily accessible with public transport and car <a href="https://www.worldforum.nl/en/congress/accessibility">https://www.worldforum.nl/en/congress/accessibility</a>
  World Forum has a parking garage at their disposal and is located directly underneath and next to World Forum. The garage has an overhead clearance of maximum 2 meters.
- Unloading all materials is on Wednesday 27.08.2025. There is no parking/storage available at the World Forum (separate from the parking garage of the World Forum) before your unloading time shift. We have found a grower and another location where there is enough space to park bigger vehicles than 2 meter (this is about a half-hour drive from the World Forum).
- When all candidates are known at the end of March, we will know the number of participants and we can ask what kind of transport your materials will use to arrive in The Hague and based on that we will make a schedule with shifts for delivering materials.
- The World Forum is a beautiful building, but the route that all materials have to take from the vehicle is very low and narrow in terms of ceiling, sprinkler system and door dimensions. Everything has to go up by elevator. So the maximum dimension, to get everything in, is the height of a Danish CC trolley and the width of 2 Danish CC trolleys tightly against each other.

## There are 4 docks:

- 2 of which you drive your truck into at height (inside) > numbered red with 1 and 4
- 1 of which you drive your truck into at height (outside) > numbered red with 3
- 1 of loading and unloading 'on the ground floor' and then up with an elevator > numbered red with 2















- We are now working on a video that shows you the route from unloading to Atlantic and Pacific. You will receive an email about this when it is ready.
- When you unload all materials, the materials from task 1 (Free arrangement, inspired by a Dutch Tulip vase) you immediately bring them to your space in Atlantic and do not go to Pacific (This way we maintain sufficient space and overview everywhere).
- On Wednesday we will allow time in the timetable, during which you may assemble your constructions for the competition with one additional person other than your registered assistant.
- In addition to your own preparation area in Pacific, we have limited space available in Altantic (separate from your own booth) to store materials that you do not need during the competition, but are necessary for transport. This speeds up the packing and loading process on Sunday.
- There is no water supply in Atlantic and there are several water points available in Pacific.
